

Changes to Certification Criteria

The Certification Committee of the Canadian Council for Career Development (CCCD) is in the process of developing criteria for national reciprocity of Certification. This would mean that a Practitioner certified in New Brunswick would have their Certification recognized in any other Province which has Certification.

In order to bring the NB Certification requirements in line with other provinces, we will be making the following small changes.

- 1. The minimum length of the Ethical Practice in the Career Development course will be increased from 7 hours to 10 hours.
- 2. Applicants for Certification must indicate that they:
 - o are practicing in New Brunswick;
 - o are practicing in more than one Province but reside in New Brunswick;
 - are currently not practicing the Career Development field but intent to work in New Brunswick.
- 3. Applicants must certify that they have not been convicted of a criminal offence for which a pardon has <u>NOT</u> been granted <u>AND</u> that would have contravened the Code of Ethics of the Canadian Standards and Guidelines for Career Development Practitioners.
- 4. Certification may be revoked if:
 - Membership in NBCDAG is not kept active;
 - Certification is not renewed when required;
 - o NBCDAG determines the Practitioner has provided false or misleading information.
- 5. Applicants must agree that NBCDAG may validate or confirm any information submitted on the initial or renewal application form.
- The number of hours of professional development required for renewal will be increased from 24 hours to 30 hours (in a three year period). This will become effective for anyone applying for Certification after December 1st, 2015.
